Administrative Order 26-01

On December 23, 2025, the court entered an Administrative Order (“AO”) in In Re: Procedures for Entering a Stay in New IEEPA Tariff Cases (“AO 25-02”), staying, upon commencement and without further action by the court, all then unassigned and new cases involving claims arising from and seeking relief relating to the announcement or imposition of tariffs invoking IEEPA through Executive Orders 14193, 14194, 14195, or 14257, as amended, and which invoke the court’s jurisdiction under 28 U.S.C. § 1581(i) (referred to therein as “New IEEPA Tariff Cases”).

Any case currently stayed pursuant to AO 25-02 shall remain stayed until an assigned judge takes action to lift the stay or otherwise modify the terms thereof; it is hereby **ORDERED** that AO 25-02 is otherwise rescinded and its automatic stay shall not be entered in new IEEPA tariff cases filed with the court after the date of this Administrative Order, and any New IEEPA Tariff Cases in which AO 25-02 has not yet been entered.
