On October 23, 2025, pursuant to section 403 of the Department of Energy Organization Act,¹ the Secretary of Energy (Secretary) released a proposed advance notice of proposed rulemaking (proposed ANOPR) for consideration and final action by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission).²

Interested persons are invited to submit comments regarding the proposed ANOPR. Comments are due on or before November 14, 2025. Reply comments are due on or before November 28, 2025.

Comments must refer to Docket No. RM26-4-000 and include the commenter's name, the organization they represent, if applicable, and their address.
