 - British Retail Consortium (BRC)
 - International Featured Standards (IFS)
 - Safe Quality Foods (SQF)
 - Food Safety System Certification (FSSC)

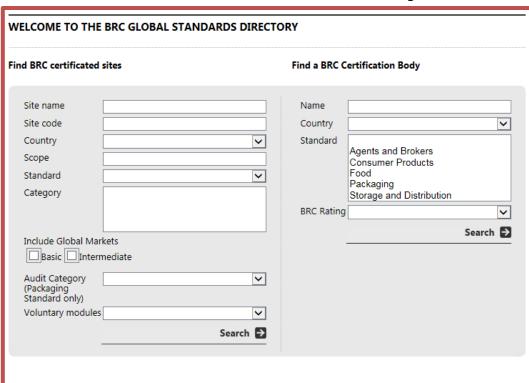

 - Availability of Auditors
 - RegionalPresence
 - Scheduling
 - Audit Duration
 - Costs
 - CertificationBody's Rating



HOW TO SEARCH THE DIRECTORY FOR CERTIFICATED SUPPLIERS

Site name

If you know the name of the company you wish to view, enter the company name in full or in part. The search will list all possible matches. Only sites currently within certification will be displayed

Scope

If you are looking for a specific product, the Scope field will complete a keyword search of all certificated site's scope descriptions. The search function is word specific and does not recognise local variances in terminology - for example a search for an aubergine will not find results for egg plants.

Category

A site search can be made Standard and Category specific by using the product category filter. Sites audited prior to July 1st 2008 will appear in the Food 4 search results.

Pre-Audits and Audits

Pre-Audits

- Optional in schemes
- More consultative
- Reduce cost and time of audit

Audits

- Observing company's system
- Identifying nonconformances, if any
